## **Nursing Workforce**

**Nurse Licensure:** Legislative discussion around Oregon entering into compact licensure for nurses will not continue at this time. This comes after <u>Washington enacted its nurse licensure compact</u> in April, becoming the 40th state to do so. The reasoning behind the bill's halt is unclear at this time.

**Rules Advisory Committee (RAC) for Division 45:** OSBN is seeking members for a RAC to guide discussions around Standards and Scope of Practice for RNs and LPNs in Oregon. To sign up to participate, email colin.butterly@osbn.oregon.gov no later than <u>TODAY</u>, May 5.

**CNA Consolidation, Curriculum, and Testing:** OSBN will host <u>a public listening session</u> on the potential consolidation of CNA1 and CNA2 certifications on May 30 at 10 a.m. Community input and commentary are welcome. There is also <u>a work session</u> to address Senate Bill 703, which would introduce Oregon CNA education and testing in Spanish, on May 8 at 3 p.m.

**Public Transportation in Astoria, Oregon:** Following an announcement that the Sunset Empire Transportation District suspended <u>Sunday operations</u>, the Oregon Department of Transport provided financial assistance to maintain the service. Buses will begin running again this weekend. The reaction came partly due to advocacy work by a fellow huddler—a powerful reminder to use your network and have essential conversations!

**Graduation Season:** Nursing programs across the state are preparing for graduation! New graduates are finding success in securing post-graduate employment. Walla Walla University reported that an estimated 75 percent of graduating students have job offers. The University of Portland said a majority of graduating students are weighing numerous job opportunities. Congratulations to our new nurses!
