## **Nursing Workforce**

**Updates to CMS Guidelines:** CMS announced yesterday its <u>rolling back vaccine mandates</u>. Huddlers discussed the change for healthcare professionals and how it impacts nursing students navigating clinical placements with practice partners. Additional guidance is needed based on <u>other updated guidelines</u> from the Oregon Health Authority (OHA). OCN will contact OHA for clarity on this matter and share insights soon.

**Defining Fully Vaccinated:** We discussed the definition of *fully vaccinated*, considering boosters and bivariant iterations of the COVID-19 vaccine. One Huddler pointed out that it is highly dependent on your vaccine history. The CDC offers one <u>definition</u> of being fully vaccinated in its FAQ section.

## **Nursing Education**

**Barriers to Nursing Education:** This week's conversation covered various barriers to nursing education at length. Inconsistencies and lack of clarity around vaccine requirements for clinical placement sites make coordinating student placement assignments difficult. We also discussed how to evaluate simulation-based education in various nursing education programs statewide. It is a powerful teaching tool but not an apple-to-apples trade for clinical learning opportunities. Another Huddler pointed out that practice partners are critical in helping navigate these barriers and should be part of the conversation.
