Nursing Workforce

Flu Vaccines for Oregon Healthcare Workers: New data shows that <u>flu vaccination rates</u> remain low amongst healthcare workers this year, according to OHA. Huddlers discussed how this might result from vaccine exhaustion following the pandemic and overall diminished trust in public health. Several attendees shared their own vulnerable experiences and perspectives around choosing whether or not to get a flu vaccination, as well as the importance of respect for others' personal beliefs. In addition, OHA has a <u>Healthcare Provider Influenza Vaccination Tool Kit</u> with helpful resources for talking to patients, employees, and community members about flu vaccine options.

Updates from OSBN: The RAC working on Division 61, which explores the potential combining of CNA-1 and CNA-2 licenses, will present its recommendations during the November OSBN meeting. In addition, there are <u>several opportunities to get involved with RACs</u>, including <u>Division 31</u> the (deadline to volunteer is today, October 27) and <u>Division 47</u> (the deadline to volunteer is November 20).
