Funded by a federal grant, the ONEA is part of a nationwide effort to increase the number of nurse educators in America. The program offers a fully-funded scholarship to the OHSU Masters in Nursing Education program. Any BSN-prepared nurse in Oregon is <u>eligible to apply before the priority deadline</u> of May 31 or the final deadline of mid-July.
