Nursing Workforce

CNA 1 & CNA 2 Consolidation: OSBN hosted a <u>Lunch & Learn</u> session on August 28 to discuss the consolidation of CNA 1 and CNA 2s. There will be a 12-month transition period, which began on July 1, 2024. Final consolidation will happen by June 30, 2025. Current CNA 2s will be grandfathered into initial competency validation. OSBN will also be hosting a <u>Lunch & Learn</u> session on Oct 2, 2024, about Division 63.

RN Delegation: OSBN will be hosting a <u>Lunch & Learn</u> session on September 3, 2024 to discuss the revised rules on RN delegation process in community based care settings (Division 47).

Positions on Select ONA Cabinets Available: ONA reported that opening for new members on the <u>Cabinet for Health Policy</u> and on the <u>Cabinet on Nursing Practice and Research</u>. Enrollment in Nursing Programs: OHSU campuses at La Grande and Klamath Fall are seeing the number of applications for nursing school decline this year. Both campuses report being unable to fill their incoming cohorts. According to OHSU, this has not happened in recent memory. Huddlers then discussed acceptance rates for new students in Oregon's nursing programs, which is around 30 percent. Huddlers also discussed factors leading to low acceptance rates, which include, faculty, clinical placements, classroom space, and the communities need for nurses.
